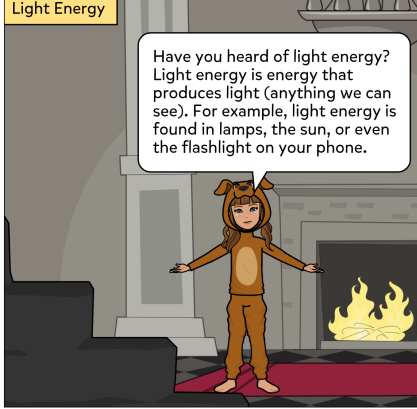


Light Energy

Have you heard of light energy? Light energy is energy that produces light (anything we can see). For example, light energy is found in lamps, the sun, or even the flashlight on your phone.



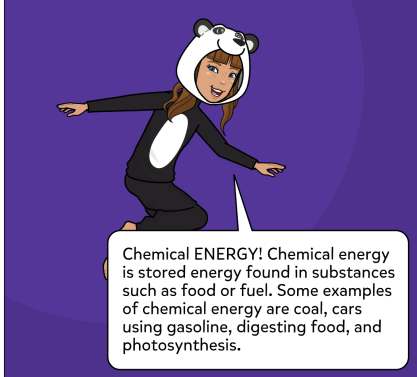
Mechanical Energy

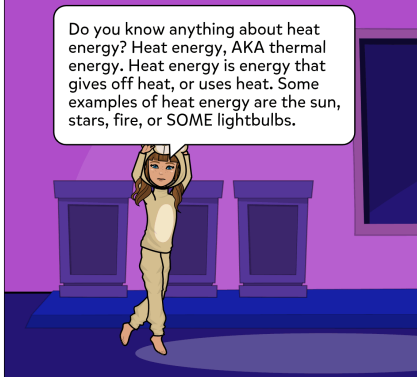
Chemical Energy
