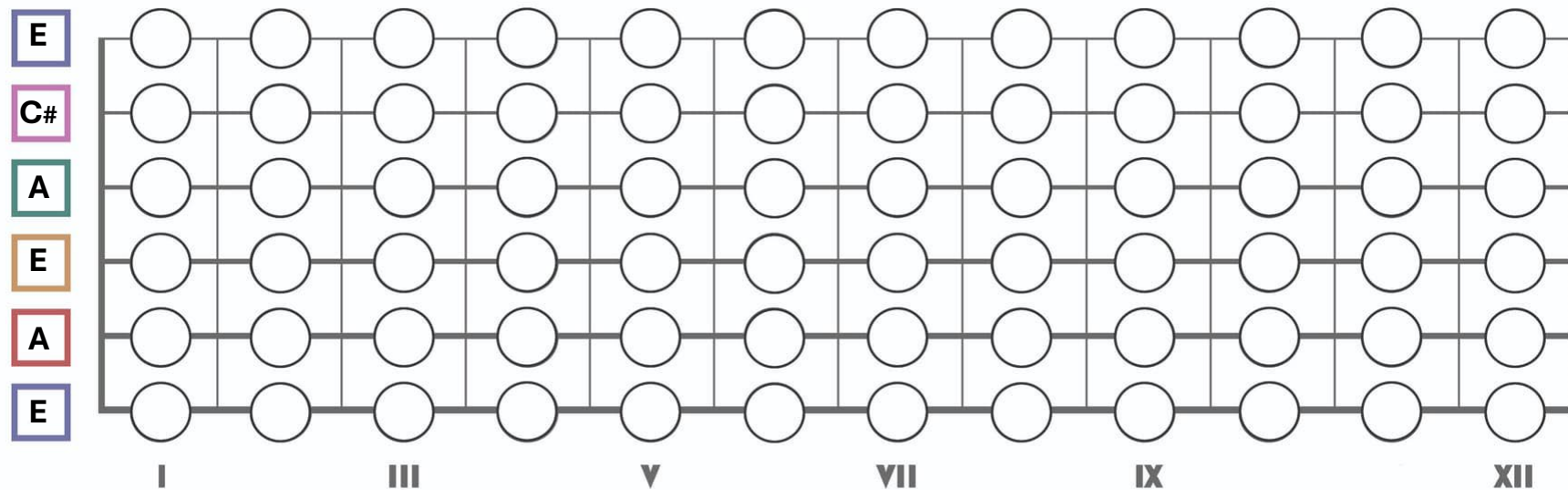

Fretboard Diagram-“Open A” tuning

The squares on the left side of the page are for labeling the pitches of the open strings. The strings are shown from the highest pitched string on the top, to the lowest pitched string on the bottom. The circles along each string are for labeling each pitch along the string in ½ step increments. The Roman numerals along the bottom of the diagram represent the frets.
